**(PPT 7-15)**In the current academic year of the school, Rev. Father Sylvester D'Souza is the Chairman of the Governing Body, Rev. Father Sandeep Kumar is the Correspondent of School, Rev. On October 02<sup>nd</sup> we made efforts to clean the environment around. School play group, LKG and UKG celebrated a special day to increase the intellectual capacity of the children, first of which was **Green Day, Red Day**. – The school has done the work of making children aware of colors by celebrating the days.

(PPT 72-74) Sports are a tool for man's mind and physical fitness. School sports festival was organized in our school on 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> of October. We also organised group games to develop sports spirit.

(PPT 75-78) In order to find out the scientific elements in children and to motivate them, On August 12<sup>th</sup> the students made models to complement the learning which had been of great success.

(PPT 79-85) Competitions enhance a person's personality, logical attitude. we organized five competitions in our school as **Essay writing** competition on June 16<sup>th</sup>, **painting competition** on 15<sup>th</sup> July and **fancy dress** competition, on 2<sup>nd</sup> September, **flower arrangement competition, a craft competition were organised** to make decorative home items from environmentally unwanted materials. We also organize **MaggiMela, Quiz** and other Competitions once a month.

(PPT 86-88) From this year for the first time we allowed our students to participate in various competitions with children from other CBSE schools. In the **zonal level sports meet** that was held at Bellary on September 09<sup>th</sup> the girls of our school participated in the volleyball match and played well thus secured the second position at the zonal level and secured a good position in the first attempt .And also in the extra- curricular activities such as essay and speech competition held at Vijayanagara Hospet students participated and gave a good performance.

**(PPT 89-91)** Mount Carmel Schools Games were organized on October 3<sup>rd</sup> at Kadaganchi, Kalaburagi in which our school 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> class girls won first position in Kho- Kho, third position in Boys Kho- Kho, second position in Boys Throw ball, and second position in Girls Throw Ball.

**(PPT 92-93)** 8std. students of our school won gold medal in **International Olympiad handwriting competition** and brought glory to the school. The students of our school participated in the **painting competition** organized as part of the 67th Annual Insurance Week of the Life Insurance Corporation of India and won awards. The teachers are training the children as a preparation for many other competitions such as colored house painting competition, Olympiad, Science, Mathematics, Essay, Painting and General Knowledge.

**(PPT 94-97)** **Smart board** classes are very useful for learning in this modern age of technology and students also like them so, we have installed 3 digital smart boards in our school. Teachers have been specially trained for its use and professional skills and internet based trainings were organized for teachers on 15<sup>th</sup> of June. .

**(PPT 98-99)** At the interest of students' security, installation of modern technology **CC cameras and technology**- based new sound amplifiers have been installed to keep students disciplined in every classroom. Also iron gates and iron mats have been placed at the doors of each floor and a special sound system has been installed in the school premises.

**(PPT 100-103)** Responding to the pain of human beings is a humanitarian, especially in the case of grief, speaking words of comfort is the essence of humanity. The school has expressed its condolences at the untimely death of Hanumappa Seshagiri, the father of our school student Rajeshree. The teachers and students of our school visited their home and prayed to God to comfort the family.

For the first time in the history of our school the houses of students' were visited by the teachers On 9th of September and December where they gave information and guidance.

**(PPT 104-116)** Apart from all the academic and non- academic activities. Mrs. Netravati, manager of Canara Bank, has given **scholarship** from the bank to 5 students of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes of the school. Special classes are being conducted for slow learning children. From the month of January special classes have been started for the poor children who are very backward in learning. **Separate concrete** space has been reserved for school buses during rainy season. Green notice boards are hung to inform the children about various topics. A separate conductor's room for school conductors and a special sitting room for parents for distance visits have been constructed.

We have celebrated **annual day on 20<sup>th</sup> December 2023** with great enthusiasm, this year annual day brought great success and positivity in the minds of parents .On this auspicious day ,best attendance student awards were distributed and food was served to all the parents, students and staff members.

**(PPT 117-126)** Considering every 9th period as **Zero hour** the class teachers are guiding the students concerning Kannada and Hindi copy writing methods. **Hand writing plays** a vital role in the life of students which helps the ability to recall and remember the information and strengthen the memory .so to help our students to improve their handwriting ,this year on 17<sup>th</sup> January ,1 month handwriting course is introduced in our institution and it is running successfully.

At the interest of cleanliness, installation of dust bins in school grounds, hanging of maps, related to each lesson, installation of new desks and coloring in the classroom have been made attractive. Lesson plan for teachers, preparation of blue print, annual work plan, disciplined dress code for teachers, separate new office, availability of black and white Xerox machine, such facilities have been undertaken. An open day is provided to the parents at each examination with the aim of informing the parents of the students' examination performance. This year by the help of Dhananjay's parents who passed 10th class examination 2 chairs have been donated.

All the good work of the school has been possible with the cooperation of our qualified and dedicated faculty. Our thanks to the management committee of our school for their able guidance and encouragement. If I were to put all the events at MOUNT CARMEL SCHOOL in a Nutshell, we encourage a child to observe, to explore, to experiment ,to probe, to analyze, to confront problems & find the solutions, Finally to develop the skills essential to face the future.
